FRESHMEN/SOPHOMORE CHURCH ATTENDANCE

Freshmen and Sophomore's will not be attending church services on Sunday morning. Your required church service will be provided as a campus experience on Sunday evenings at 6.15 in the Chapel. This is a decision of the President's Cabinet. There are two reasons for this decision. First, most area churches, if they are open for live services have capacity limits. We cannot overwhelm these churches with Northpoint students so that their own congregants cannot attend. Second, we are trying to keep our campus community safe. The less we are all out in public, the less chance we have of becoming exposed to Covid-19.

There is one exception. Freshmen and Sophomore students are allowed to attend their home church. However, you must fill out the form that is attached with this email, submit it to taskforce@northpoint.edu, and **you will receive notice of approval.**

GOING HOME ON WEEK-ENDS

If you go home for the weekend, it is policy to fill out the Student Request Form. This form found online at the website under helpful links. Once the form is filled out, your ID card will be deactivated. When you return to campus you must go to the security. Security will ask you questions from the Health Form, take your temperature, and then reactivate your card. Again, please know these policies are for the safety of the campus.

FACEMASK POLICY

Please remember to follow the protocols for wearing your facemask. Here is the policy:

“Effective immediately and until further notice, anyone (age two and up) outdoors on the Northpoint Bible College campus that is unable to or does not maintain a distance of six (6) feet from every other person is required to cover their mouth and nose by wearing a face covering or mask. Anyone indoors in public areas of the Institution is required to wear a face covering or mask at all times.

Employees working alone in their offices, resident students and families, staff and families who are in their assigned college-owned housing do not need to wear masks or face coverings, but anytime in public areas of the Institution, masks are required.”

When you are outside and do not maintain a distance of 6 feet you are required to wear a facemask.
