### **Testing and the Student Body**

Thank you for your corporation with Testing this week. Everything went well and everyone tested negative except one staff member. They are in isolation and we have others in quarantine because of exposure to this person. Please be diligent in wearing your mask and social distancing yourselves from others.

### **Testing this Week**

Next week, all students, faculty, staff and residents whose last names begin with **A-K** need to take their next Covid-19 test Wednesday, March 24, from 7:30 am to 11:00 am in the Library Conference room. Go right up the circular stairs in the Library and it will be the first door on your left at the top. Reminder, this test is not optional. Please note that the testing will conclude at **11:00 am**. Please come right before or after your morning classes to get tested quickly. If you do not have a morning class, please come as soon as possible and not later. All you will need to do is show up to administer the self-test. We are anticipating the process to take less than 5 minutes.

Also, if you don't show up for testing on the day you are supposed to, you will not be allowed back on campus without proof that you have taken a Covid-19 test off campus within a specific time frame.

**\*Reminder, if you do not show up on time for testing you will have an automatic warning.**

### **Testing for the Remaining of the Semester**

We will not have testing March 31 or April 7, because of Easter break. You will not have to come back to campus with a Covid Test, because it would be too soon if you had any exposure. We will instead test the **Entire Campus** April 14 and April 21. We will not be testing the last week of school on April 28.

With this please be very cautious over Easter break. We want to have our end of the year Celebrations, like Senior Banquet and Graduation.
