Testing this Week

Next week, **ALL** students, faculty, staff and residents need to take their next Covid-19 test Wednesday, April 21, from 7:30 am to 11:00 am in the Library Conference room. Go right up the circular stairs in the Library and it will be the first door on your left at the top. Reminder, this test is not optional. Please note that the testing will conclude at **11:00 am**. There are no classes this day, so please come right away and get it done. We don't want everyone to come right at the end. That will not be helpful. All you will need to do is show up to administer the self-test. We are anticipating the process to take less than 5 minutes.

Also, if you don't show up for testing on the day you are supposed to, you will not be allowed back on campus without proof that you have taken a Covid-19 test off campus within a specific time frame.

***Reminder, if you do not show up on time for testing you will have an automatic warning.**
