

## **Light in the Darkness**

During the darkest days of the pandemic in 2020, I saw a video in which doctors and nurses stood atop the Cartersville, Georgia, hospital and sang a song written by a Nigerian lady: "Waymaker, Miracle Worker, Promise Keeper, Light in the darkness, My God, that is who You are" (Osinachi Kalu Okoro Egbu).

As grim as those days were, it seems a year later the medical, political, economic, emotional, moral, and religious climate in our world keeps getting worse. Truly, we are walking in dark times. "An entire system of spiritual darkness—spearheaded by Satan himself, carried out by hordes of demons, and influencing every corner of earth—rages right below the surface of our everyday lives" (Marshal Legal).

Dark days? Yes, but God is not afraid of the dark! And we have a promise given to us by the Promise Keeper.

Through the Prophet Isaiah, God promised a day when "people that walked in darkness" would see a "great light" (Isaiah 9:2). From the context, we understand that the great light He promised was a Person. This Person was to be unique in that He was to be born to a virgin and then named Immanuel—meaning "God with us" (Isaiah 7:14). He will be called "Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace," and His unending government will be peaceful and characterized by true justice (Isaiah 9:6-7).

Jesus is the promised Light. Jesus declared, "I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness but shall have the light of life." (John 8:12).

This Christmas Season let us not curse the darkness, but rather let's be light bearers (Matthew 5:14-16). Let's dispel the darkness by spreading peace and God's will on the earth.
