



Massachusetts Health Insurance Requirement

As of August 1, 2006 students enrolled in a school approved by the Massachusetts Board of Education must be covered by an active health insurance policy. Students who do not have personal health insurance which meets the guidelines specified below are required to purchase the College's approved insurance plan while enrolled as a student.

Students who are currently covered under a health insurance plan may request to waive the College's plan by submitting proof of coverage for the academic year of enrollment and affirm that the plan meets the following guidelines established by the Division of Health Care Finance and Policy.

- Coverage is active throughout the current academic year (beginning and ending in August).
- Coverage meets the following minimum requirements for care.
 - The plan includes preventive care services (physical exams, ... etc.).
 - The plan provides primary care services (for illness , etc.).
 - The plan offers coverage for emergency services. The plan covers surgical services. The plan provides hospitalization benefits.
 - The plan includes ambulatory patient services.
 - The plan offers mental health services. Coverage is accessible in the area where the student attends school (i.e. the student can obtain these services in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts).

Please attach a copy of your insurance card for our records. If you have comparable insurance according to the above guidelines and desire to waive Northpoint's student insurance, you will be required to complete a Health Insurance Waiver form upon registration
