

GRADUATE SCHOOL OUTCOMES

Our accreditors (The Association for Biblical Higher Education) define an outcome as “a consequence or end-result of an activity/set of activities that has been measured and can be demonstrated to be the product of those activities. An outcome communicates demonstrated result.” An outcome is predicated upon objectives which they define as “an anticipated or intended result of an activity/set of activities that is specific and measurable. An objective communicates sought-after or desired result.”

Due to the stresses Covid-19 placed on educational institutions and student’s such as Northpoint, a conscious decision was made that during the last two years that no outcomes data would be gathered. The Summer 2022 semester will be the first semester that data will be once again gathered at the graduate level. According to the current academic policies, data is gathered for each course in which a professor was evaluated. Furthermore, the professor has until September 15, 2022, to submit their data to their divisional chair. The divisional chair then has until October 1 to review the material to make sure it is correct. The data will be available to the public once it has been distilled and formatted for the public. *The ABHE established timeline for having graduate school outcomes published is November 15, 2022.*
