

UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM OUTCOMES

Our accreditors (The Association for Biblical Higher Education) define an outcome as “a consequence or end-result of an activity/set of activities that has been measured and can be demonstrated to be the product of those activities. An outcome communicates demonstrated result.” An outcome is predicated upon objectives which they define as “an anticipated or intended result of an activity/set of activities that is specific and measurable. An objective communicates sought-after or desired result.”

Due to the stresses Covid-19 placed on educational institutions and student’s such as Northpoint, a conscious decision was made that during the last two years no outcomes data would be gathered. In the Spring 2022 semester data was once again gathered. According to the current academic policies, data is gathered for each course in which a professor was evaluated. Furthermore, the professor has until the May 16, 2022, to submit their data to their divisional chair. The divisional chair then has until June 1 to review the material to make sure it is correct. The data will be available to the public once it has been distilled and formatted for the public. *The ABHE established timeline for having undergraduate program outcomes published is November 15, 2022.*
